AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Farmington:

SECTION 1 That the corporate limits of the City of Farmington shall be and remain as fixed by an act of the legislature of Iowa entitled "An Act to Incorporate the City of Farmington," approved February 22, 1847, which are as follows, namely:

SECTION 2 All that part or tract of land lying in the Township Sixty-Eight (68) North and fractional Township Sixty-Seven (67) North, Range Eight (8) West, in the County of Van Buren, as is comprised in town plat of Farmington and North Farmington, East Farmington or Stewart's Addition, Booth's Addition to Farmington, Referee's Plat Addition, Gafford's Addition, Thero's Addition, Barton's Addition, Bower's Addition, Kelley's Addition, Vacated Vector Addition, and Victory Park Addition, Out Lots of Farmington Proper and Out Blocks of East Farmington as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Van Buren County Iowa, together with all additions that may hereafter be made and recorded thereto, also to the middle of the Des Moines River opposite the said plats.
