Halbrook made a motion to set a special meeting for March 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6pm with Budget workshop to follow at 6:30pm. Seconded by Gobush, motion carried 3-0. Halbrook made a motion to approve adding Christmas Eve and December 26<sup>th</sup> to full time employees paid holidays effective immediately. Seconded by Burkett, carried 3-0. Council decided to keep city wide yard sales on second weekend in May, this year falling on May 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. Halbrook made a motion to approve Banyon as new software for city clerk to convert after July 1, 2025. Seconded by Gobush, carried 3-0.

Other business: Council discussed issue of tractor trailers driving on residential streets with weight limits or restricted access posing safety risks and wear/tear on roads.
